

## List of artists for Blickachsen 13

**Contemporary art in historic park landscapes: this summer 24 artists from different countries will present 34 works in the thirteenth Blickachsen Sculpture Biennale in Bad Homburg, Germany.**

From **14 May until 1 October 2023** the **thirteenth edition of Blickachsen** will once again bring together the most varied positions in contemporary art, including numerous works specially created for the exhibition as well as site specific projects. The exhibition will extend in **Bad Homburg** from Lenné's Kurpark to the landgraviate castle's Schlosspark, showing a broad spectrum of contemporary sculpture and installation art curated by Blickachsen founder Christian K. Scheffel together with Roland Nachtigäller, the director of this year's partner institution, the Stiftung Insel Hombroich (Insel Hombroich Foundation) in Neuss.
